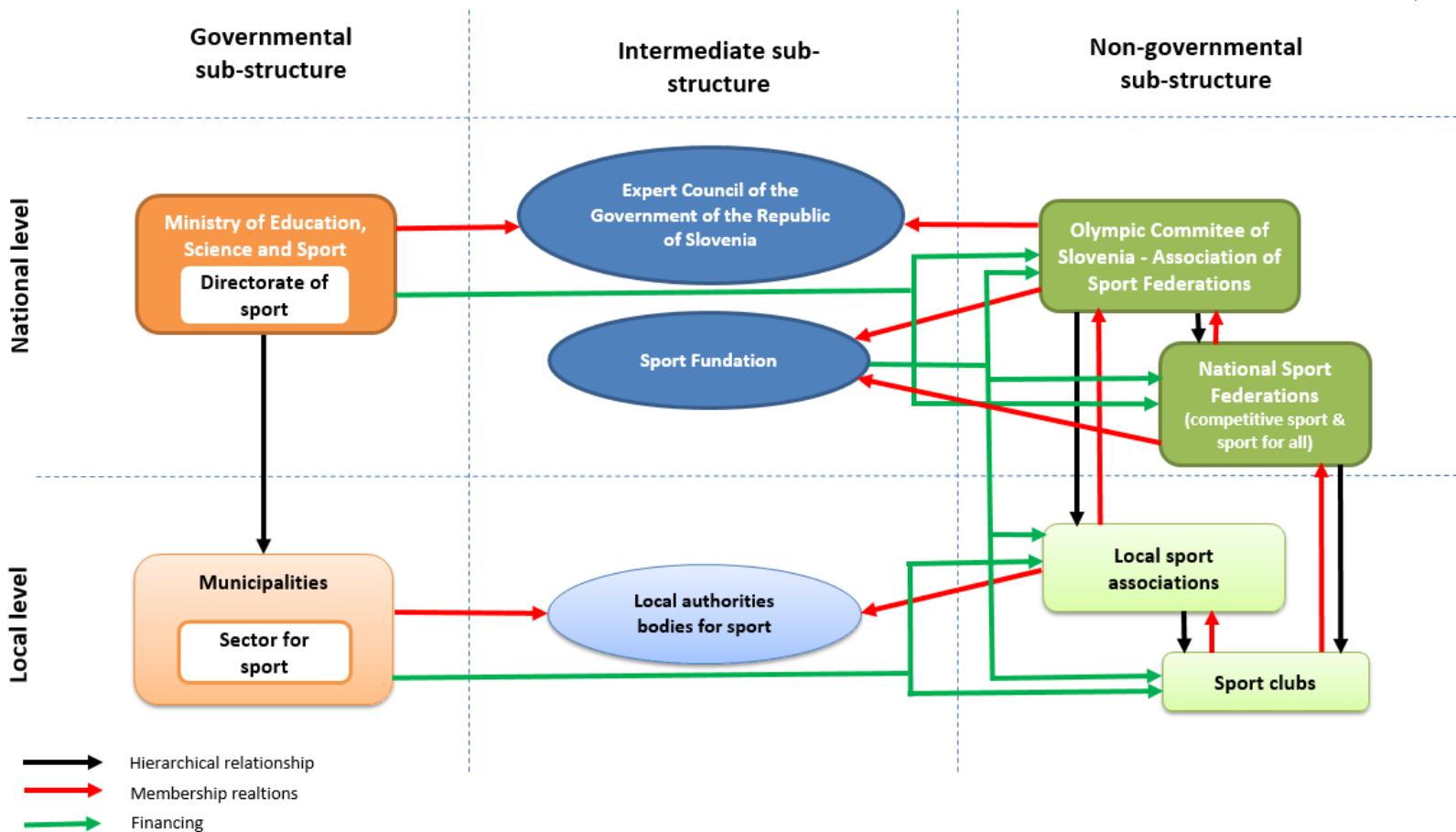

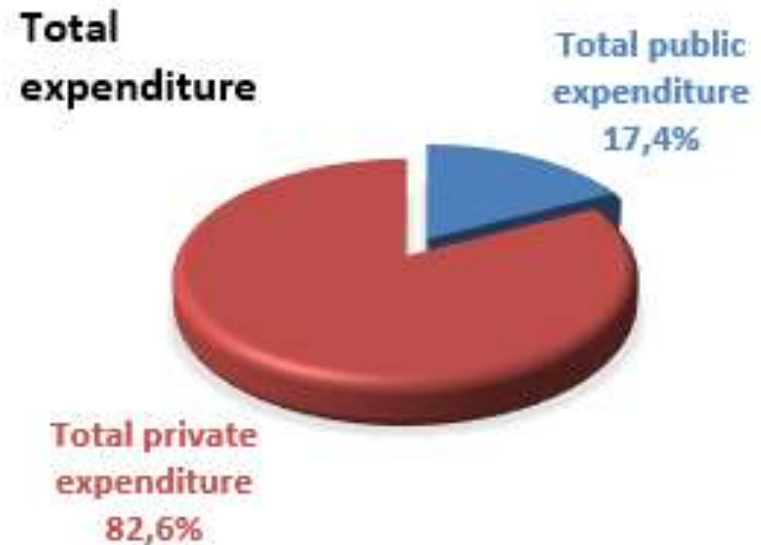

3 Financial framework

- Annual expenditure on sport in Slovenia represent around 2% of GDP.
- The average Slovenian householder spends 2,88% of the family budget on sport, equating to 496€/year.



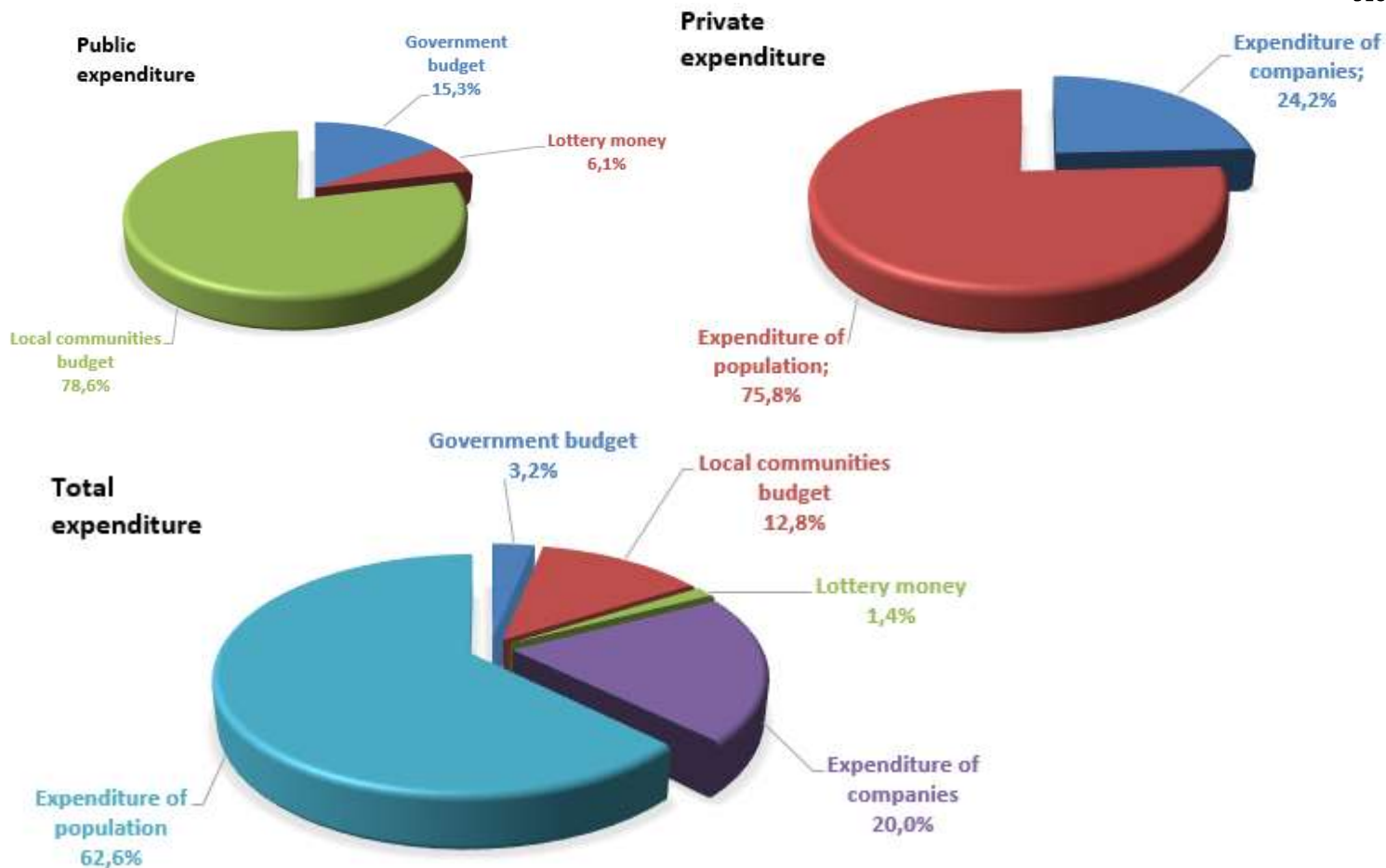

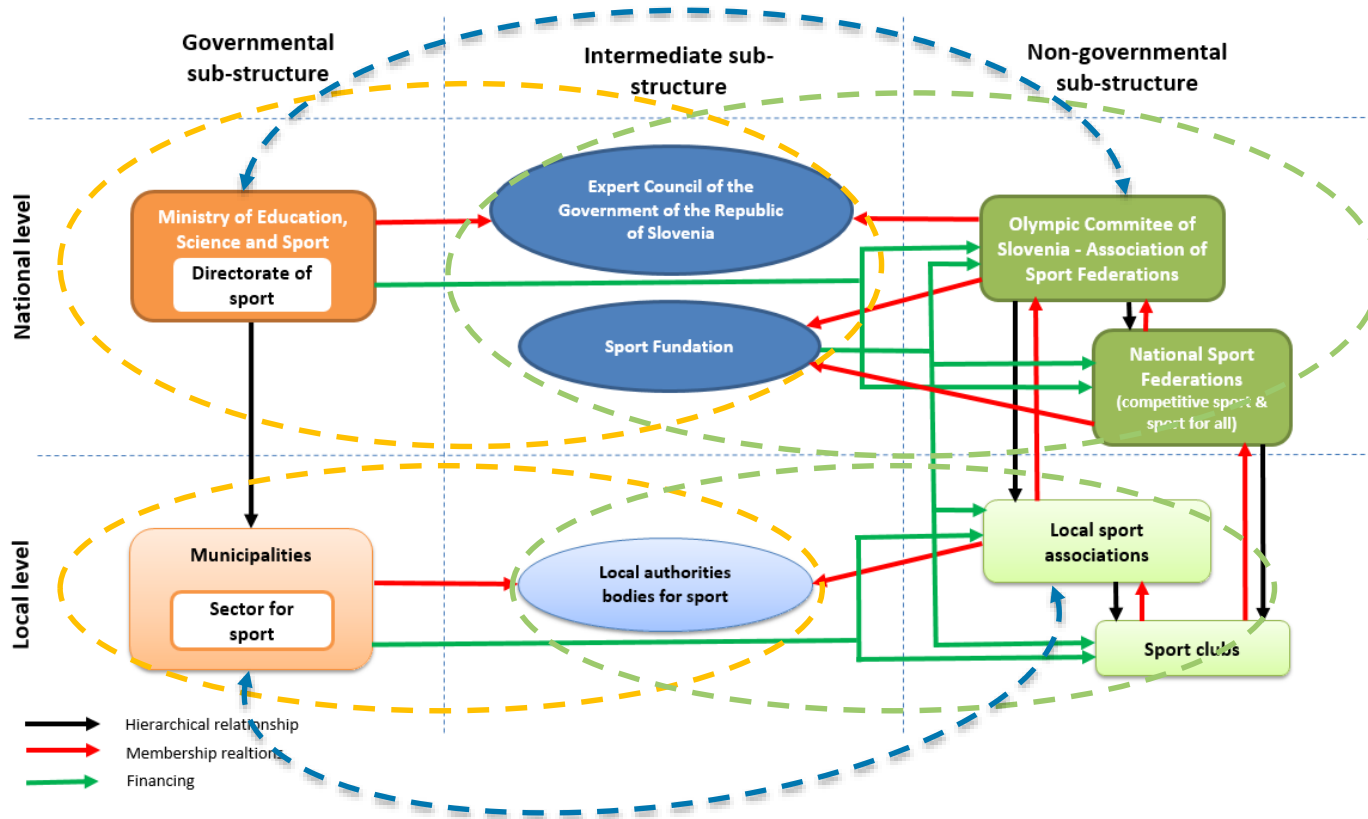

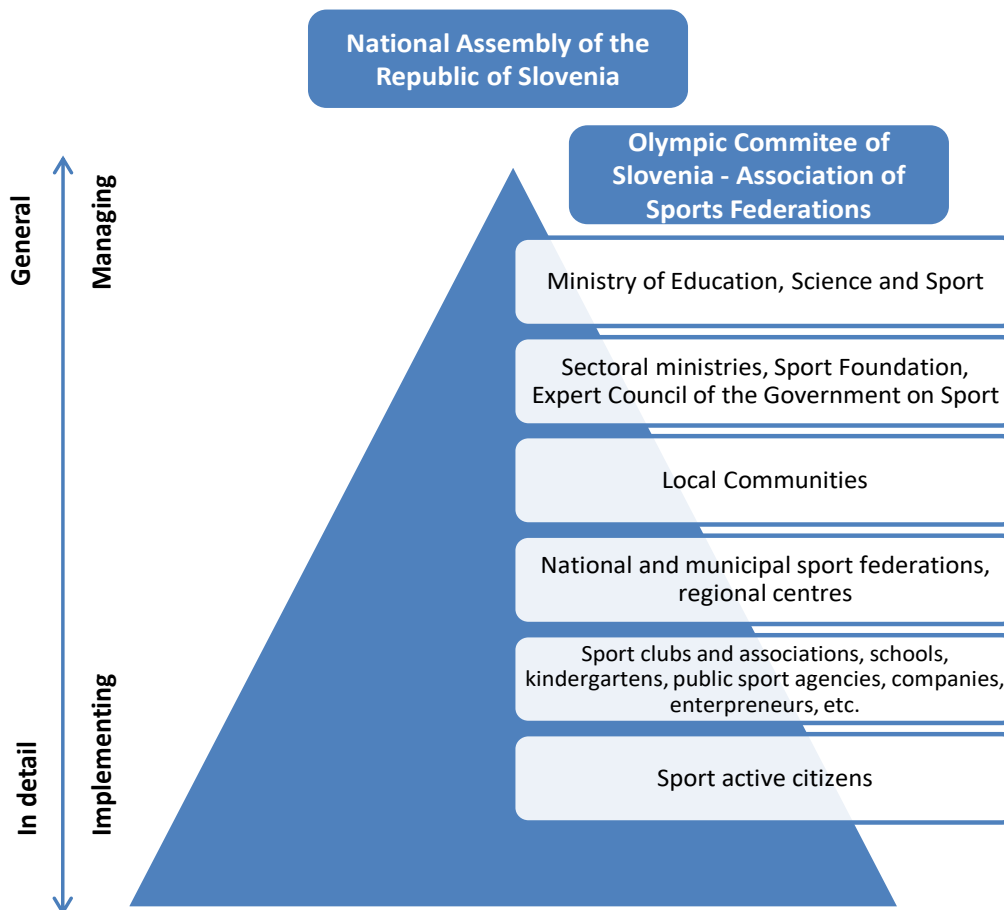
